I.D.

I.D. is an uplifting duet that celebrates race, culture and gender diversity through a sound and movement journey. Vince Johnson and Francois Zayas use their fluency in multiple styles within their respective disciplines to slide between genre and identities. Their message is that we are all connected. Johnson fuses influences from hip hop, martial arts and contemporary dance into aerodynamic expressions of grace and control. Zayas delivers ear-bending beats, sewing a quilt of percussive textures from around the world.

CRUMBLE TO CREATION

Crumble to Creation is a fun and engaging performance that explores the the fluidity between destruction and creation, the fractured and the whole. The music and movement uses recognizable genres of jazz, funk, rock, hip hop and rumba layered or mutated to challenge audience expectation. The work is made to simultaneously uplift and captivate children and parents alike. Performers emerge from and dissolve into the audience, supporting audience participation and interaction. The dancers contort, fly, fall, collide, glide, redirect, and animate. Crumble to Creation poetically presents brokenness in all its humor, perplexity and beauty through music and dance.

WHO WE ARE

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Vince Johnson is a Philadelphia based artist and educator. Hip hop dance and martial arts have been his primary disciplines since childhood. He has also studied physical theater, clown, and percussion. He is alumnus of Rennie Harris Puremovement and has worked in various art sectors. He is founding director of Movemakers Philly and Urban Movement Arts. Both organizations function as community resource centers for a broad range of performing artists and dance practitioners.

MUSIC DIRECTOR

Francois Zayas is a composer, arranger and percussionist. Born in Cuba, Zayas graduated from and taught at the Instituto Superior de Artes (ISA) in 1998. He was also a member of the National Symphonic Orchestra of Cuba. From 1994 to his establishment in the USA in 2006, he made several international tours with different groups. Francois directs Philly Music Factory.
